The policy was drafted and approved by members of the P and F and staff.</p> <p>AB+M, project managers are currently working with the school to submit an application for P21 Federal Funding - "Upgrade and Refurbishment of School Library and Completion of Multi-Purpose Area Providing for The Arts and Physical Education".</p> <p>In term one St Kevin's was successful in receiving a grant of \$150 000 (BER - P21, Capital funding) to be used to improve teaching and learning facilities.</p> <p>In their roles as school leaders all senior students have completed a term in one of four service ministries.</p> <p>The school website is active and updated regularly.</p> <p>Parents and Friends, staff and students have been involved in discussions regarding priorities for development in the school.</p>

The P and F Fete Committee has worked co-operatively with school administration, staff and the parish to organise St Kevin's Fete to be held in May.  The P and F have instigated fortnightly reports for parents in the school newsletter.
